We have 24 learners attending and they will be coming home with information for their whanau about this event, today.

Each of our teaching teams have been working hard, great to see Team Kakano head out to watch the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch show on Wednesday. They travelled to the Mangere Arts Centre and from all accounts the show was very much enjoyed by our Junior learners.

Thank you to all of our FBS whanau for your support and encouragement for our learners and staff. As a school we can achieve anything when we are all working together.
